The “Winter Emergency Period”, often referred to as the moratorium, ends April 15th. After that date, utilities statewide may begin to disconnect electric service to customers who are past due on payment of their utility bills. The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin enables the moratorium to protect customers from

disconnection during harsh Wisconsin winters. To prevent disconnection, we urge our customers to pay their past due balances as soon as possible. Please call our office at 715-526-3131 if you have any concerns about paying your past due balance.

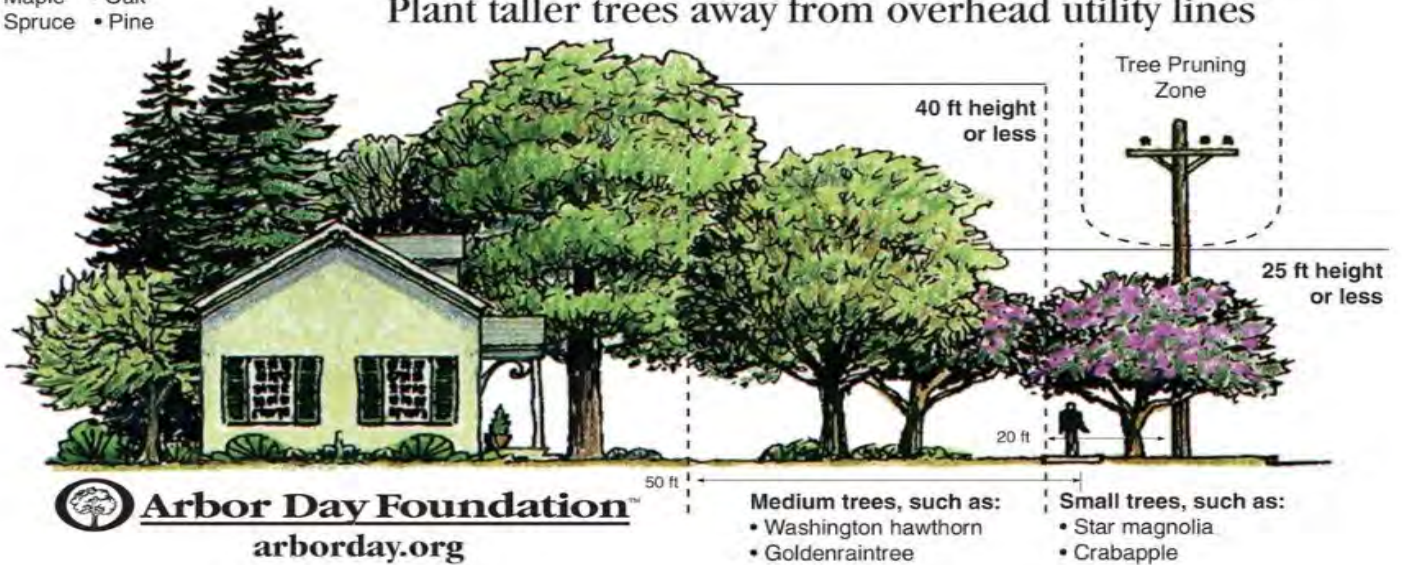
